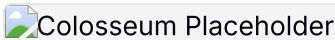

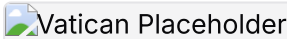

# Getting Around Rome

Everything you need to navigate the city — by metro, bus, tram, taxi, and on foot.

## Metro

Rome has two main metro lines (A and B). Line A serves key tourist areas including the Vatican (Ottaviano), Spanish Steps (Spagna), and Termini. Tickets: €1.50 single / €7.00 day pass.

## Bus & Tram

Buses cover the entire city and run until midnight (night buses after). Trams serve several key routes. Same €1.50 ticket is valid for 100 minutes on any combination of buses/trams.

Tip: Validate your ticket when boarding — inspectors do check!

## Taxi & Ride Share

Official taxis are white. Fixed fares apply from major locations (airport, train station). Apps: itTaxi, FREE NOW. Avoid unmarked cabs.

## Airport Connections

Fiumicino (FCO): Leonardo Express train to Termini (€14, 32 min) or FL1 to Trastevere. Ciampino (CIA): COTRAL bus to Termini or taxi (~€30 fixed).

## Bike & Scooter

Electric scooters (Lime, Bird, Helbiz) and e-bikes are available across the city. Ideal for short distances. Watch for cobblestones!

## On Foot

Rome's historic center is very walkable. Most major sights are within 30–45 min on foot from the B&B. Wear comfortable shoes — cobblestones are beautiful but uneven!

## Safety & Scams

- Watch for pickpockets in crowded areas (Colosseum, Termini, busy buses)
- Avoid 'bracelet' or 'rose' vendors who insist on giving 'free' gifts
- Only take official white taxis or use a ride-share app
- Restaurants near major tourist attractions often charge more — explore 1-2 streets away
- Emergency number: 112 | Police: 113 | Medical: 118

## Dining Etiquette

- Coperto (cover charge, €1-3) is normal and legal — it is not a scam

- Cappuccino is a morning drink — ordering one after lunch raises eyebrows!
- Stand at the bar for cheaper coffee — sitting doubles the price
- Tipping is not mandatory, but rounding up or leaving €1–2 is appreciated
- Restaurants typically open for lunch 12:30–15:00 and dinner 19:30–23:00

### **Dress Code & Etiquette**

---

- Churches require covered shoulders and knees — carry a scarf or shawl
- The Vatican has strict dress code — no shorts, no bare shoulders
- Do not sit on fountain ledges — it is illegal and fined
- Speaking quietly in sacred spaces is greatly appreciated

### **Health & Pharmacies**

---

Pharmacies (Farmacia, green cross sign) can help with minor ailments and many medications available over-the-counter. Nearest pharmacy: [Address]. Hospital: [Name, Address].
